7.1 Purchase Item Agreement over \$50,000

7.1.1 Network Security Services

Authorization is requested to enter an agreement with <u>Connection, Inc. (Merrimack, NH)</u> in the amount of \$696,906 to provide Cyber Security services for four years. This purchase will be funded from general budget.
